Minutes of 5th EXTERNAL BoS Meeting – CSE

Opening Remarks:

Dr Ramachandran Chairman, BoS, CSE invited all the members and presented the agenda of the meeting. The softcopies of important documents for the meeting are shared to the members. Dr. Ramachandran formally revealed the progress of current R19 and R20 batches of students and their performance, in curriculum perspective.

Later, he presented the R20 Regulation course structure approved in earlier (4th) external BOS. He presented the R20 IV Year Complete Syllabus. After a brief scrutiny external members made their

advices and remarks. A thorough conformance of curriculum with that of stipulations made by standards academic governing bodies AICTE, APSCHE and JNTUK was also done.

The confirmed minutes after the 5th External BoS meeting held on 28th May 2023 are inscribed below.

Item 7.1: Confirmation of 4th EXTERNAL BoS meeting minutes

Prof G.Sanjay Gandhi, member of BoS, CSE presented the analysis report on execution of R19 and R20 existing syllabus and stated that its being done in a formal way without any deviations in syllabus perspective.

The BoS members confirmed the 4th BoS meeting minutes.

Resolution 7.1:

Confirmed the 4th BoS meeting minutes and unanimously approved and decided to continue same efforts.

Item 7.2: Review of R20 B. Tech CSE IV year I-Sem and II-Sem Course Structure & Detailed Syllabus.

Dr.Ramachandran V, presented the R20 IV year I and II Semesters complete syllabus. Subject Experts and Module Coordinators, demonstrated their course syllabus. The key points are,

- Inclusion of Power BI as Skill Advanced Course is appreciated by Industry Nominee.
- Prof. E.S.Reddy garu, advised the Members to include rearrange the Professional Electives order to reflect path-ways
- Prof MHM Krishna Prasad garu suggested that Number of Hours for a Course shall be within 45 clock hours considering the feasibility.
- The detailed syllabus of MEAN Stack Technologies is lauded by Alumni Nominee and Industry Nominees.
- As per the discussion held, the Internships can be done in hybrid mode (online/offline), the committee decided.

Resolution 7.2:

The proposed IV Year B. Tech R20 Course Structure and syllabus are in conformance with that of AICTE, APSCHE and JNTUK's recent 2021 guidelines, in the credit break up and layout. Internships can be done in hybrid mode.

The detailed syllabus for each course in IV-1 and IV-2(Project with internship and Seminar) are approved by the members. The committee appreciated the inclusion of InfyTQ Spring Board and EPAM while designing the syllabus of advanced subjects.

Item 7.3: Regarding Minor and Honours Degrees

Dr Ramachandran revealed the status and progress of Minor Degree in CSE course.

For Honours course, as there are no aspirants, committee opined that the structure, guidelines and action plan for Honours courses to be intact.

As per the MOOCs courses related to the fulfilment of Minor or Honour Courses, ONLY completion of course is considered, irrespective of Marks/ Grades/ Mapped Credits, as elicited by the committee.

Resolution 7.3: The Minor courses offered by CSE department are approved by the members. In the aspect of Minor related MOOCs (NPTEL) Courses, the completion itself is treated as sufficient and the clause of 7.75 credit rule is NOT mandatory.

Item 7.4: Guidelines to be adopted in implementing the program for R20 IV-2 project.

Regarding, the IV- 2 Semester Project, Prof ES Reddy garu suggested that the work done in the projects to be presented in a Conference or Journal as a Publication, to encourage research in students.

Prof M.H.M Krishna Prasad garu advised that as per earlier JNTUK Community Service Project guidelines, 4 credits shall be given to CSP from the 12 credits of major project. The evaluation of CSP shall be done IV-1.

Resolution 7.4: The committee unanimously approved the Major Project Guidelines are as per JNTUK norms. Project must include Internship with seminar. The Community Service Project must get 4 credits from 12 credits of Major Project of IV year -II Semester.

Item 7.5: Any other with the permission of Chair

As no other points rose by the members, the meeting ended with concluding remarks and read-out of excerpts by the Chairmen BoS of CSE.
