The Chairman welcomed the members to the IQAC meeting, followed by the discussion on the items of the agenda which were circulated among the members and corresponding resolutions were made.

Agenda Point 1: T&P Activities & Industry Internship Activities-Outcomes

Chairman, IQAC revealed the T&P activities to all the members and welcomed the suggestions.

The members after browsing through statistics, opined that a rigorous training is being organized 24X7, which can be viewed as satisfactory, for if changes were required based on the company requirements in selection procedure. The Chair, mentioned that for this A.Y the placements were started in a slow pace but of much better quality like TCS, Mu-Sigma etc,

that shows the stamina and quality of students. The Committee felt that the Industry Internship activities must be improved and interlinked with the T&P activities further.

Resolution 1: The committee decided to interlink Training Placement activities with the Industry Institution Interaction for a better throughput for the students. Chair requested the concerned member to follow up with an action plan.

Agenda Point 2: Social Block Chain Team & Progress

Chairman, IQAC reported on the formation and activities of Social Block Chain Team (SBT) and requested members to share their views upon the same for its swift success. The members discussed about the same. The active functioning of the same is visible but to yield products or services it still needs its course of action plan to be completed through this entire A.Y.

Agenda Point 3: NSS & NCC and quality of activities

Chairman IQAC gave a quick review on the list of activities done on the Byndr LMS and asked the members discuss on further usage of the same. Many members appreciated the way how Byndr LMS is used for attendance, assignments, material transfer and mentoring along

with the content delivery, course files, notes, tutorials etc. The members added that Byndr can be tuned even higher for the quick, accurate & qualitative transfer of information outside the class room for the students.

Resolution 5: Chair, IQAC and members of the Committee unanimously agreed to increase the utilization of Byndr LMS as it was proven as a quality means of transfer of information among the students, course instructors and institute in a qualitative way.
